Consult your CLB 2000 to determine the skill and CLB level of the following tasks:

1. Phone your teacher and leave a brief voice mail message. Ask her to call you back. Leave your phone number.
Skill: S CLB level: 4
2. Take down the information from a pre-recorded phone message with six details.
Skill: L CLB level: 7
3. You want a library card. Answer several basic personal information questions, such as:
 - What's your name?
 - Where do you live?
 - What's your phone number?Skill: S CLB level: 1
4. Ask a pharmacist for information about cold medications so you can get the best product for a sore throat and cough. You don't want something that will make you drowsy during the day.
Skill: S CLB level: 5
5. Choose 3 of your new words. Find them in the dictionary and copy the definition, the pronunciation and an example of the word in a sentence into your word book. You have 30 minutes.
Skill: W CLB level: 3
6. Write a 1 or 2 paragraph article for the school newspaper describing the field trip the class went on last week. Tell where we went, what we saw and what you thought about the experience. You have 30 minutes.
Skill: W CLB level: 6
7. Read a 2 paragraph news article and answer 7 questions about the text.
Skill: R CLB level: 4
8. Read a 10-paragraph magazine article about global warming from a popular science magazine and summarize the text in 150-200 words.
