Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages

TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages), TESL (Teaching English as a Second Language) and TEFL (Teaching English as a Foreign Language) are all terms used to describe the same thing - teaching the English language.

The number of TESOL opportunities continues to increase as the use of English as the language of business, science, and technology spreads globally.

There are opportunities worldwide in private language schools, elementary and secondary schools and colleges and universities.

The countries with TESOL opportunities include Japan, Korea, Taiwan, China, Latin America, Europe and the Middle East. There are also teaching opportunities in private language schools in Canada.

What qualifications do you need to teach English?

Schools look for candidates who enjoy people, have good communications skills, and want to learn about different cultures. A TESOL certificate and a Bachelor's degree* are also generally required.

*Not all opportunities require a Bachelor's degree. However, TESL Canada Professional Certification Standard One is not available for those without a Bachelor's degree.
