## Introduction

This resource was compiled to assist prospective Adult English as an Additional Language (EAL)<sup>1</sup> teachers in their job search. Information contained within is current as of June 2007; however, the field is ever-evolving and some changes may have occurred since its printing.

Adult EAL is an area of educational expertise. Generally, programs are looking for adult educators who have a combination of training and experience in teaching EAL.

Furthermore, TESL Canada, the national professional organization of EAL educators, is developing certification standards for programs, teachers and TESL programs. The Province of Manitoba is interested in implementing the program and teacher standards in its funded programs throughout the province; consequently, prospective teachers are encouraged to acquire TESL Canada Teacher Certification to enhance their employment possibilities. ### ADULT EAL IN MANITOBA

Adult English as an Additional Language (EAL) instruction in Manitoba is coordinated through the Adult Language Training (ALT) Branch of Manitoba Labour and Immigration. There is a range of programming options through government-funded adult EAL programs offered in schools and colleges, by community organizations and by employers and unions.

- ✧ Government-funded programs are open to immigrants to Manitoba and citizens who were born outside of Canada and are generally free of charge to the students or require a nominal “administrative” fee.
  - Private schools and programs are open to immigrants, citizens and international students and charge a tuition fee.
- ✧ Government-funded programs are fiscally accountable to government and are also accountable for the educational quality of their programs and their adherence to Manitoba Adult EAL Curriculum Guidelines.
  - Private schools and programs are not regulated by, nor accountable to, government. **THEREFORE, INCLUSION OF PRIVATE PROGRAMS IN THIS RESOURCE IS A COURTESY TO TEACHERS SEEKING EMPLOYMENT AND SHOULD NOT BE CONSIDERED AN ENDORSEMENT OF THE PROGRAM.**

<sup>1</sup> Manitoba has introduced the term English as an Additional Language (EAL) in place of English as a Second Language (ESL). In this resource both terms are used depending on the situation.

## GOVERNMENT-FUNDED ADULT EAL INSTRUCTION

In Manitoba, there are several types of Adult EAL programs:

- ✧ School and college-based programs
- ✧ Community-based programs
- ✧ Workplace-based programs
- ✧ Skills programs

Most of these programs are located in Winnipeg, but there are a number of programs also offered in other regions of Manitoba including:

- ✧ Westman (Brandon and area)
- ✧ Portage la Prairie and area
- ✧ Norman (northern Manitoba)
- ✧ Parkland South (Roblin/Russell and Birtle)
- ✧ Parkland North (Dauphin, Swan River and area)
- ✧ Pembina Valley (Winkler/Morden and area)
- ✧ Southeast (Steinbach and area)
- ✧ Interlake (Gimli and area)

There is a range of full and part-time programming offered days, evenings and weekends, depending on the programs and learner needs.

- ✧ In Manitoba, the curriculum delivered in government-funded Adult EAL programs is developed by teachers and reflects Manitoba Adult EAL Curriculum Guidelines. These guidelines emphasize the importance of:
  - Learner needs
  - *Canadian Language Benchmarks* levels
  - Stakeholder concerns
  - Adult language learning principles

### ADULT EAL INSTRUCTION IN WINNPEG

Learners who need language training make an appointment with the Winnipeg English Language Assessment & Referral Centre for a *Canadian Language Benchmarks* assessment. Following the assessment, the learner and assessor discuss the goals and needs of the learner, and a referral to an appropriate program is made. Generally, the following referrals are made:

- ✧ Learners from *CLB* 1 – 6 needing day, evening or weekend, part-time, regular EAL with a focus on settlement information are referred to Winnipeg School Division - Adult EAL Centre of Winnipeg;
- ✧ Learners from *CLB* 1 – 8 and ESL Literacy, living in the south end of Winnipeg, who need part-time evening school, are referred to Winnipeg Technical College.
- ✧ Learners from *CLB* 1 – 6 needing full-time classes weekdays with a focus on settlement information are referred to Winnipeg Technical College.
- ✧ Learners from *CLB* 3 – 8+ needing full-time classes weekdays with a focus on employment preparation or needing an English for Specific Purposes (ESP) course are referred to Red River College Language Training Centre;

- ✧ Learners who have had little education and have limited reading and writing skills in their first language are referred to the EAL Literacy program in the Winnipeg School Division - Adult EAL Centre of Winnipeg;
- ✧ Women with child care needs are referred to the Community EAL classes for Women;
- ✧ Learners 55 and over, and who are not destined for the labour market, are referred to Age and Opportunity;
- ✧ Learners from CLB 5+, who are business people or professionals and need focused instruction on a particular aspect of their language, are referred to the English Skills Centre.

Learners may also occasionally be referred to other programs depending on their needs, such as to Literacy programs for the general public or Adult Learning Centres. In addition, many employers of immigrants may identify some language learning concerns and work with ALT Branch to develop an EAL program for their work site.

Once in the program, the teacher is responsible for identifying the specific needs of the learner and incorporating those concerns into curriculum development and lesson planning. Task-based instruction is an integral part of the teaching/learning process in government-funded adult programs.

Teachers in programs funded by the government are expected to provide their learners with feedback on their progress in learning English. A Collaborative Language Portfolio Assessment approach is used, in which samples of learner progress are collected throughout the program and used by the teacher and learner to discuss progress. Progress discussions may occur informally throughout the course with a more formal feedback session at the end of the course, complete with a progress report. In full-time programs, formal feedback sessions are scheduled twice during the year. The report that learners receive is a standardized report developed by ALT Branch for the programs. Use of a standard report facilitates movement of learners from one program to another and increases its familiarity among mainstream programs and services.
